President's Message

I am saddened to inform you that **Joel Miele, Sr**, PE passed away several weeks ago. Joel Miele was a past president of the Queens Chapter of NYSSPE, past president of the NYSSPE, Commissioner of the NYC Dept. of Environmental Protection, NYC Department of Buildings, and Board of Standards and Appeals. Joel was a friend of the Chapter and he never said no to me when the Chapter needed something from him. Anything we would need he was more than accommodating and helpful. May his memory be eternal and in his memory the Chapter will make a donation to the American Parkinsons Disease Association.

After Superstorm Sandy hit last year, many of our members, myself included volunteered and offered assistance to the public. But did you know that you could be held liable for your actions and that your insurance carrier may not cover you? The Good Samaritan Act A 4380-A (Englebright), S 3942 (Hannon) will help shield licensed design professionals from lawsuits for volunteering and assisting the public in a declared emergency. The American Institute of Architects (AIA) has taken the lead and has sponsored legislation in both the assembly and senate. "The proposed bill will provide professional engineers, architects, landscape architects and land surveyors immunity from liability for providing volunteer services during times of crisis and catastrophe. Such immunity would not be applied in cases of wanton, willful, or intentional misconduct, nor to services provided more than 90 days after the termination of the disaster or emergency. This legislation shall not affect the liability of any government which requests a volunteer to perform these services." We need you to write the governor, your NY State assemblyman and NYS senator and tell them to pass the bill.

Re: Good Samaritan Act

A 4380-A (Englebright), referred to Assembly Higher Education Committee

S 3942 (Hannon), referred to Veterans, Homeland Security and Military Affairs Committee

Dear Senator/Assemblyman,

The devastation caused by Hurricane Sandy impels every New Yorker to help each other. We have seen remarkable examples of volunteerism - indeed, outright heroism in the days and weeks following the storm. The efforts of so many citizens to assist others, both friends and strangers, impacted by Hurricane Sandy display courage, compassion and caring.

Our AIA Brooklyn, neighboring Staten Island, and Queens members have witnessed the devastation first hand as we have joined our neighbors in recovery efforts. AIA members have also answered the call to assist our Government's responders with critical damage assessments of the homes and businesses impacted by the storm. As members of AIA we have a vested interest: many of our members, and their families, live and work in the communities impacted by Sandy. We are committed to helping our friends and neighbors rebuild as we all work to put our lives back together.

Unfortunately, we face a problem as volunteers: the State of New York does not provide immunity from liability for volunteer services rendered by professionals during a declared state of emergency, generally known as "Good Samaritan" protection. Furthermore, while Architects may already have professional liability insurance, that insurance may not cover any actions they may take while acting as a "volunteer." We want to help, we can help – but cannot risk adding to the losses we have already sustained in this disaster.

AIA New York State has been proactively advocating changes to cover "Good Samaritan" actions in times of declared disasters, but the legislature has not acted. The devastation caused by Super-storm Sandy should be a wakeup call.

In addition to the Architects who have already responded, many more Architects and Engineers in the New York area, and beyond, have come forward and indicated a willingness to volunteer in the short-term recovery efforts. Other concerns regarding the re-design of infrastructure and design of new coastal protections are long-term issues. People need help – and we are prepared and willing to assist. We have reached out to Governor Cuomo and the legislative leaders urging that action on this matter be addressed during the up-coming session of the legislature.

Our neighbors, upstate, downstate, Long Island and many others, need help now. Many more people will need help in future emergencies. Please help the AIA secure liability protection for Licensed Professional disaster response volunteers by lending your support to Good Samaritan Protection during the up-coming session of the New York State Legislature.
