President's Message

I hope everyone had a safe and healthy summer. another testing laboratory was indicted by the district attorney for falsifying inspection test reports at various construction sites throughout the city. The testing company is being accused of falsifying concrete test reports and not performing the required special inspections. The testing lab was operating as an INC and is not a Professional Corporation (PC). The state society and our chapter has repeatedly requested that the Building Department only allow PCs or firms with a Certificate of Authorization from the NY State Education Department to perform (718) 352-0025 inspections. We as well as the NY State Education Dept. believe these special inspections constitute the practice of engineering.

> Several months ago the NYC Dept. of Building Commissioner appointed a non licensed individual to a position (deputy borough commissioner) that was generally held by a license design professional, ie. RA or PE. Our state society has written a letter to the NYC attorney expressing the society's concerns with the appointment of a non license design professional. The NY City attorney wrote back that the job description was changed to preferred PE/RA from required PE/RA and that he knows of no law that requires a license for this position. According to members who practice at the Building Department, this position requires engineering decisions such as review of variances, Certificate of Occupancy, code interpretation, etc.

SUBJECT: Acting Deputy Borough Commissioner of Brooklyn position

Dear Mr. Cardozo:

On behalf of the New York State Society of Professional Engineers, Inc., an organization representing over 20,000 professional engineers statewide, I am writing to advise you of our concern regarding the recent appointment of Frank Marchiano as the Brooklyn Deputy Borough Commissioner at the Department of Buildings. It is our opinion that this position requires the expertise of a licensed design professional (professional engineer or a registered architect). This position requires interaction with licensed design professionals and the public seeking assistance with specific technical matters pertaining to the NYC Building Codes. These technical matters include acting upon design reconsiderations, interpreting the NYC Building Codes, reviewing construction documents for code compliance, and various other issues that affect the health and safety of the public. Customarily this position has been filled by a licensed professional, and not surprising, the attached NYC job description actually requires the Deputy Borough Commissioner to be either a PE or an RA because it involves the practice of engineering/architecture.

I have attached the Department of Buildings organizational chart, which shows Acting Deputy Commissioner Frank Marchiano as a registered architect, RA. Our research on the NYS License Verification website does not include Mr. Marchiano on the list of registered architects. If this correct, we believe that the acting DOB Deputy Borough Commissioner of Brooklyn, Mr. Frank Marchiano should be removed immediately from this position and a qualified licensed candidate currently registered to practice in New York State be considered.

I write in response to your May 19, 2011 letter regarding the appointment of Frank Marchiano as the Department of Buildings' Deputy Brooklyn Borough Commissioner. In your letter, you contend that (1) this position must be filled by a New York State licensed professional engineer ("PE") or registered architect ("RA") because it is a position that involves interaction with licensed design professionals and the public pertaining to technical Building Code matters; (2) the posting for the position required that the Deputy Borough Commissioner ("DBC") be a PE or RA; and (3) the Department of Buildings' organizational chart shows Acting DBC Marchiano to be registered architect, whereas he is not a registered architect.

I am advised that, as a threshold matter, the Department of Buildings is well acquainted with the quality of Mr. Marchiano's work and skills and considers him to be fully competent to handle the position of Acting DBC in Brooklyn. I note that there is no legal requirement that that such a position be filled by a New York State licensed PE or RA.

Moreover, I am told that the posting you appended to your letter, dated November 3, 2010 and posted on the Department's internal website, was in fact superseded by a subsequent internal job posting, dated May 6, 2011, pursuant to which Acting DBC Marchiano was appointed. This more recent posting (a copy of which is attached) did not specify that the qualified individual was required to be a New York State licensed PE or RA; rather, as you can see, it stated that "[s]trong preference will be given to Registered Architects and Professional Engineers in the state of New York."

Finally, I am told that there was a clerical error on the Administration page of the Department of Buildings' website that included "RA" after Acting DBC Marchiano's name. This

has been corrected on the website by removing the "RA" notation, and the agency appreciates your pointing out that error.

I trust this is responsive to your concerns.




